### SWANKY SURF SHACK

« RON ROOZEN'S, MARGARET RIVER, WA

On a hillside at Prevelly on WA's south-west coast, about three and a half hours' drive from Perth, you'll find this spectacular beach house designed by acclaimed Sydney-based architect Dale Jones-Evans. It's the home of local artist and surfer Ron Roozen, whose partner, Karen Siddall, managed Margaret River's prestigious Cape Lodge for 10 years. And her hand in this enterprise is apparent. The attention to detail is immaculate: a pantry service, in-house masseuse, daily servicing and wine tours can be arranged, or a chef can come and cook dinner while you sit back with a glass of wine from one of the local wineries and admire the surf from one of three expansive decks. Three king-size bedrooms and two bathrooms also have cinemascopic views of the Indian Ocean.

**Upside** Great food, wineries and beaches.

**Downside** Tearing yourself away from the deck.

**Rates** From \$400 per night for two. Sleeps six.
